Attended Funeral (Funeral Director's Charges Only)

^{*}In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay to pay doctors' fees. This is the charge for each doctor to sign the Medical Certificate for Cremation (usually only one doctor's signature is required). If Cremation 4 paperwork is not required, this fee is not additional.
